## Broad Guidelines for Utilization of Incentives released to the States under <u>Atal Bhujal Yojana</u>

Broad Guidelines for Utilization of Incentives released to the States under Atal Bhujal Yojana were circulated on 31.03.2021 (copy attached).

In addition, States can also take up those activities/interventions which are not part of any existing Central/State Scheme through incentive amount. Further, States may also decide on the interventions targeted for sustainable ground water management which are not part of any of the WSPs and the same can also be taken up through incentive amount.

An illustrative list of such activities is given below-

- Land levelling, Mulching, vermi compost, Agro forestry.
- Crop cultivation practices
- Value Chain including cold storage, Market linkages
- Intelligent irrigation system
- Any other area-specific water efficient/water-saving methods and practices.
- 2. However, prior concurrence of NPMU is required on such activities.
- 3. It is also suggested that State may plan in advance for the entire incentive amount which will be available to them after achieving all DLIs and start implementing as and when incentive amount is disbursed. The activities suggested under the plan may be prioritised and the funds to be utilised accordingly. Tentative incentive fund allocation for each State, after achieving all DLIs, is given in Annexure.
- 4. It is requested that the incentive fund utilisation plan, duly approved by the competent authority in the State is shared with NPMU by 30.04.2022.
